

## **Home Inspection Summary**

262 Pape Avenue - September 15, 2022

**Structure:** Brick foundation. Wood frame exterior wall construction. Wood frame party wall.

**Roof:** Asphalt shingle sloped roof and modified bitumen flat roof appear to be in good condition.

**Heating:** High-efficiency gas furnace is 2 years old. Central air conditioner is 21 years old and beyond its typical service life (\$4,000 - \$7,000 when necessary).

**Electrical**: 100 amp service with a mix of copper knob and tube wiring and aluminum wiring. The house requires a new panel (\$800 - \$1,500) and will need a complete re-wire (\$750 - \$1,500 per room).

**Plumbing:** City supply pipe is 3/4" copper. Visible interior supply plumbing is copper. Gas natural vent water heater (owned) is 2 years old.

Notes: No other significant issues were noted.
